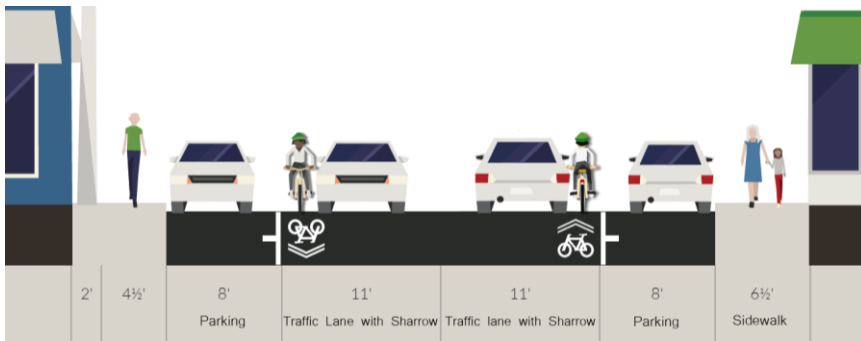


Pedestrian & Bicycle Access on Semicircular Road

This summer, the Department of Public Works will widen sidewalks and make a more bicycle friendly roadway along Semicircular Road. Funded by a One Bay Area Grant for Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements, this project is a direct result of the North Fair Oaks Community Plan which calls for improvements of pedestrian facilities and bicycle connectivity. Changes along Semicircular Road include:

- Widening of about 2,000 feet of sidewalk along Semicircular Road by two feet
- Installation of state of the art traffic loop detectors tuned to detect bicycles at four intersections: Middlefield Road & Fifth Avenue, Fifth Avenue & Waverly Avenue, Middlefield Road & Semicircular Road, and Middlefield Road & Eighth Avenue
- Installation of "sharrow" markings on Semicircular Road to make drivers aware of the potential for bicyclists along Semicircular Rd.

Construction on Semicircular Road is scheduled for summer 2015. Bids for construction are due April 23, 2015, and the project will be awarded to a contractor on May 19, 2015. See the roadway design below:



UPDATE: Middlefield Road Redesign

→ Proposals from consultants for design and traffic analysis will be reviewed in April, with a final selection by May 2015.

- Linda Lopez and Dale Miller from the NFO Community Council are participating on the selection committee for the design consultant team.
- 87 business owner interviews were completed along Middlefield Road and a survey for property owners will go out in April. Results will be shared in June 2015.
