MI INSTITUTIONAL STRATEGIES

Economic Development

MI addresses the issue of economic inequity by offering access to skills and competencies that direct workers on pathways to economic security. We provide participants with workforce development opportunities, job placement assistance, and advocate fair-wage paying jobs. Each year, over 1,000 different individuals are involved in in one or more of the following activities: employment training, job placement, housing, and educational opportunities.

Vocational/Skill Development

MI's vocational and skill development courses assist the participants in acquiring the skills and certifications required to continue on pathways to better employment and careers. 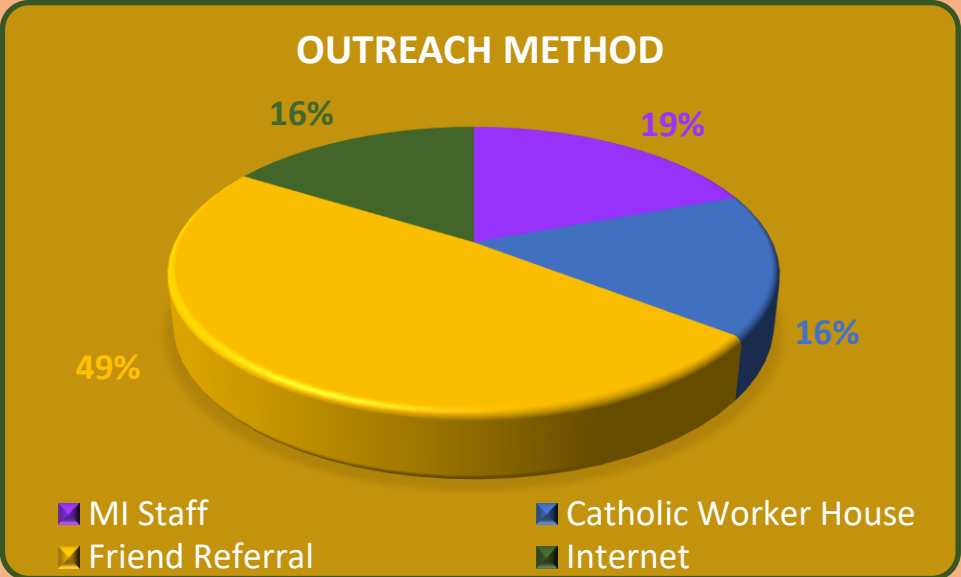
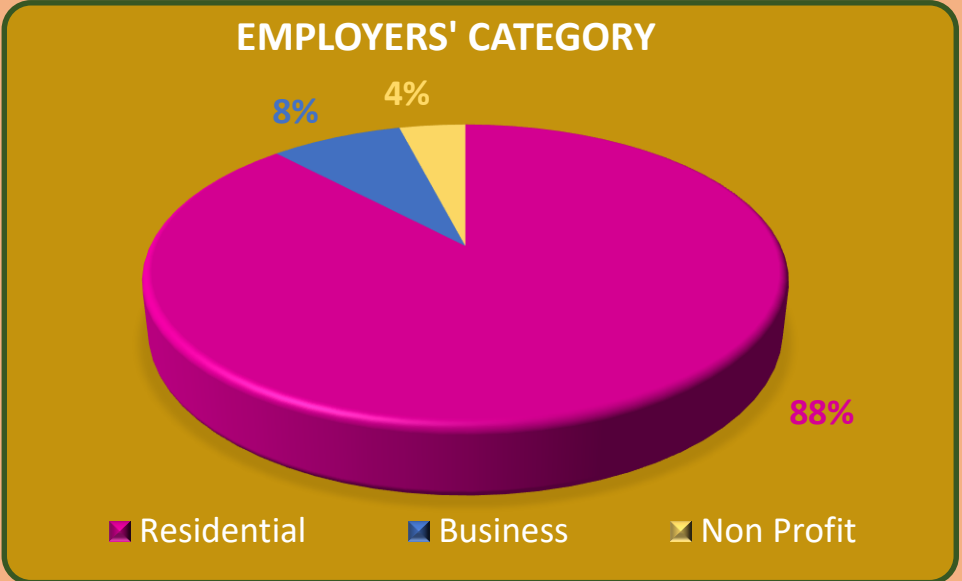
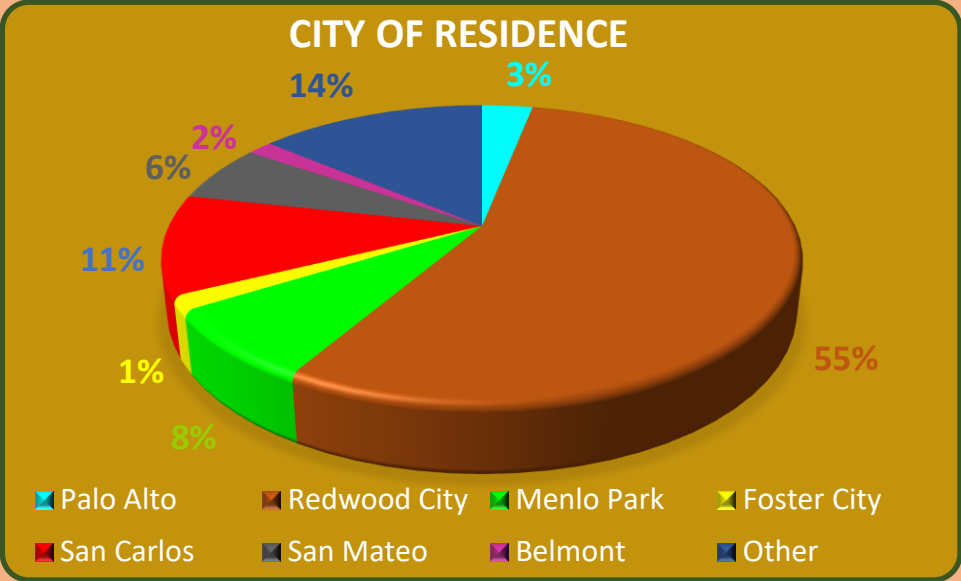
